Facility:	 East Beach, Hartwell Lake, at the CU Rowing Facility, 522 East Beach Drive, Clemson SC 29634 (GPS Coordinates: Lat: 34.677159, Long: -82.854853). Water depth depends on the spring rains, start will be 5-14 feet, and the rest of the course is 25-50 feet. Water temperature is expected to be in the low 80°F range. On-campus parking will be available. Please pay close attention to the parking attendants at the meet. Failure to comply with parking regulations will lead to ticketing by Clemson University Parking Services. Stadium seating is plentiful near the start and finish of the race. A grass area is available for tailgate type tent set-up. Spectators and swimmers are encouraged to bring chairs. There is additional viewing available on a dyke area along a portion of the course. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. 					
Rules:	Meet to be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming and SC Swimming Rules and Regulations and information herein. Important rules to highlight include: Toenails and fingernails will be checked before the race at the nail inspection area. If the nails are too long, they must be trimmed to a reasonable length at the discretion of the Referee. Wearing jewelry including watches is not allowed. No swimmer shall be allowed to use or wear any device that may be an aid to his/her speed, endurance, or buoyancy. Wet suits, flotation aids or any similar items, and anything used to maintain body heat is not allowed. Continual warm-ups will be available in an area near, but not on the course following general warm-up procedures. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. One event swimmers and non-SCLSC USA-Swimming members can only place and receive award(s) in the open event(s). Swimmers in the SCLSC should register for and swim in the SCLSC Championship event in order to place and score points in that event. All swimmers can swim in additional open events. All safety requirements will be enforced for the well-being of our swimmers. In case the race needs to be abandoned, air horns and safety craft will direct the swimmers to shore. Once on the shore walk back to the meet start where swimmers will be directed to cover. Swimmer numbers are applied to the upper arms and the backs of shoulders. Please keep these areas free of sunscreen and oil. Other than Safety and Official's boats, no additional craft will be allowed near the race course. This is a non- escorted swim.					
Athlete Eligibility:	For the general meet all swimmers and teams must be currently registered members of USA Swimming. For an additional \$15 fee, non-USA Swimming athletes may register for a USA Swimming One-Meet Membership. Only SC LSC registered swimmers are eligible to compete in the State Championship events. Age will be based on the swimmers age on the first day of the meet.					






Entry Fees:	 \$25 facility fee (includes cap and swimmer hospitality) \$2 per swimmer SCLSC Travel Fund/Program Fee (both in & out-of-state swimmers pay this fee) \$2 per out-of-state/SCLSC swimmer Travel Fund/Program Fee (out-of-state swimmers only pay this added fee) \$2 per swimmer SCLSC Sports Development Fee \$1 Jennifer Smith Scholarship Fund \$10 per each individual event \$12 per each deck entry \$15 for one day registration of athletes not registered with USA-S. Each swimmer can enter up to 4 events. SC LSC Swimmers are eligible to enter the championship events and open events. Out of LSC and one-day USA-S members are only eligible to enter the open events.
	Meet management reserves the right to alter the timeline or make any other necessary changes during the meet to provide the best and safest competition environment for the athletes. All like-distances will be seeded as a single event, without regard to a swimmer's age or gender. The Meet Director reserves the right to assign participants to waves in each event if number of entries warrants. If waves are necessary, they will be based on gender and age.
	All races are out and back, swum along a buoyed line (kept to the right of the swimmers) that follows the east shore of Hartwell Lake. Buoys are placed every 100 meters along the course. Additional markers are placed at 50, 150 and 250 meters (half-K turn) to aid in the half-K. The finish shoot and line are clearly marked. At the 1K mark, the course makes a slight dog-leg left. At this point there is a set of two buoys forming a gate through which swimmers must pass on the out portion only of the 3K and 5K races. On the return portion, swimmers simply keep the course to their right.

	Safety boats will monitor the entire course. Water and sports drink will be available on every boat on the course and at the turn. Swimmers must wear race cap, numbers on both arms and back for identification. Medical personnel will be on site.
	For the 5K events, all swimmers who have not completed the course within 2½ hours will be retired. If the water/air temperature is above USA-Swimming's Rules the event will be shortened to a distance no longer than 4.5K.
	For the 3K events, all swimmers who have not completed the course within 1 ³ / ₄ hours will be retired.

Other Information:	Directions: From Southbound Interstate 85S take exit 19B – merge right onto US76 / SC28 up to Clemson (10mi) – OR – From Northbound Interstate 85N take exit 14 – turn left on SC187 (6 mi). The road ends at the only traffic light, so turn left onto US76/SC28 toward Clemson (5mi). Either way, as you get near Clemson, take the SC93 exit and turn left onto SC93 for 1.4mi. You'll pass 5 lights, **and the soccer stadium and tennis courts on the left. Turn left at the next light and then an immediate right. Follow the signs.
	From US123, drive to downtown Clemson. At the College Avenue light (SC133, by Starbucks), turn left toward Clemson University. At the second light (at the campus, 0.7mi), turn hard right onto SC93. Follow from the ** above.
